ARIZONA PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD MINUTES OF BUDGET SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING PHOENIX, AZ

A public meeting of the Budget Subcommittee was convened on May 20, 2014, at the AZ POST facility located at 2643 E. University Drive, Phoenix, AZ.

A. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 8:35a.m. The first order of business was to select a Committee chair. Chief Campbell moved to select Chief Rodbell as chair, seconded by Mr. Brown, motion carried unanimously.

B. Discussion of Philosophical Statements for Budget Considerations

Executive Director Mann discussed Basic and In-Service Training budget needs with the Committee. Due to the increase in basic training costs, it was discussed whether allocation funding should be discontinued. The Committee's main concern was the burden this would place on small agencies. After further discussion it was determined that allocation funding will continue and agencies will be allowed to use the funding for upgrading of judgmental shooting machines/equipment and/or police training.

Currently there are two Intergovernmental Agreements (IGAs) to offset some of the costs associated with the operation and maintenance of an academy; one with ALEA and the other with SALETC. It was proposed that IGAs also be established for NARTA and WALETA to offset the same costs.

Cadet reimbursement to an academy or agency was established at \$750 for each cadet graduating from a certified program.

C. Discussion of 2014-2015 Budget Draft

The Committee members reviewed and discussed the 2014-2015 budget presented by Executive Director Mann. All agreed the budget was ready for approval by the full Board.

The Committee will meet again in September to discuss mandates and budget priorities; and also to work on a 2-3 year plan for future budget considerations.
