**A. Call to Order**

Chairman Coker called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**B. Introductions, Presentations and Announcements**

Executive Director Mann introduced new Compliance Specialist Lori Ketron and informed the Board that this will be Diana Stabler's last meeting due to her retirement. He then asked Professor Stemley to introduce the students in attendance. Professor Stemley introduced the Grand Canyon University students who are in attendance at today's meeting. These students are dual enrollment high school students who are attending GCU and taking criminal justice classes.

**C. Legislative Update**

Executive Director Mann stated there is nothing new to report since the legislature is not in session.

**D. Proposed 2014-2015 Fiscal Year Budget**

Executive Director Mann presented the 2014/2015 fiscal year budget to the Board for its approval.

Mr. Brown made a motion to adopt the proposed 2014/2015 budget as submitted, seconded by Sheriff Pribil, motion carried unanimously.

**E. AZ State Parks Petition of Behalf of Applicant Robert T. Taylor**

AZ State Parks Department petitioned the Board to determine that the pre-employment drug usage by applicant Robert T. Taylor was experimental. Executive Director Bryan Martyn addressed the Board on behalf of AZ State Parks.

After a lengthy discussion regarding the experimentation rule waiver process, Sergeant Andreacola made a motion to grant the petition for a determination that the drug usage by Robert T. Taylor was experimental, seconded by Professor Stemley, motion carried by a 4-3 vote.

**F. Bisbee Police Department Petition on Behalf of Applicant Andrew D. Deford**

The Bisbee Police Department petitioned the Board to determine that the pre-employment drug usage by applicant Andrew D. Deford was experimental. Sergeant Robert Coronado addressed the Board on behalf of the Bisbee Police Department.

Mr. Brown made a motion to grant the petition for a determination that the drug usage by Andrew D. Deford was experimental, seconded by Professor Stemley, motion carried unanimously.
