

Civil Process Class

19 hours of Continuing Training Credit

Civil Process Class is designed to provide the deputy with all the aspects associated with the service and return of civil documents from Superior Court, Justice Court and other courts of Competent Authority, including out of state entities. The student will receive training in the exact legal procedures and requirements and limitations involving Writs of Restitution (Evictions and Foreclosures for real property, rental property and mobile homes/RV parks). Students will receive instruction on Writs of Execution (Seizures and Auctions) for persons and businesses and the various avenues available to satisfy these court judgments, Writs of Garnishment and the required service documents and procedures. The class will cover aspects of Orders of Protection and Injunctions Against Harassment, Tax Collection, Tax Liens, Business and Corporate Seizures and the legal requirements and limitations including sub-service, secondary service, and the service of corporations and LLC's for all civil service of court related documents including the required collection of fees and disbursements. At the conclusion of the training students will also receive a complete and updated civil service manual that details all aspects of civil service the deputy will be encounter.
