Swatting is the act of making a false report to emergency services with the intention of drawing a large scale response and has typically been associated with computer gamers and hackers. This has been on the rise since numerous celebrities were first swatted back in 2012, and it's only growing in sophistication and popularity. This class will provide investigators, supervisors, and first responders with tools to identify, respond to, and investigate this crime, without being technically challenging.

**NOTE:** this is an interactive class involving live internet searches. Internet-enabled mobile devices can be used.
