

**This is a two day training session that has 16 hours of continuing training credit.
That covers the following two related topical areas.**

Mental Illness/Developmental Disability Train-the-Trainer

This training is highly recommended for any person who is currently teaching or wants to be a Mental Illness & Developmental Disability Instructor for Basic or Advanced Officer Training. The agenda will include a panel of experts and focus on new information and communication skills.

Prerequisite for Mental Illness/Developmental Disability – Train the Trainer Class:

It is **not** necessary to be a General Instructor (GI) to attend this course;

*** Note: Students must be a GI before they can teach this course to other Law Enforcement Officers.**

Excited Delirium/Police Suicide Awareness

This class is recommended for all officers. This course will discuss issues surrounding Excited Delirium; to include history, signs and symptoms, behavioral cues, and appropriate action steps to take if a suspect experiences an excited delirium state.

A portion of this class will also be dedicated to Police Suicide Awareness. This topic is discussed to shed light on what is considered a sensitive issue.
