

Traffic Collision Reconstruction I

*** Prerequisites**

40 Hours – Continuing Training Credit

This course is for investigators who already have a thorough understanding of technical collision investigation and can be used as a basis for becoming a Collision Reconstructionist. Topics include the role of the Reconstructionist, methods of examining the expert witness, conservation of linear momentum, time/distance problems, case studies, and acceleration studies.

*** Prerequisites for Traffic Collision Reconstruction I:**

1. Must have attended the 40- hour Advanced Collision Investigation Course or the IPTM, NUTI or NUCPS program; and
2. Must have a strong understanding of high school algebra.

Note Students must bring traffic template, calculator, and stopwatch.
