Police Supervision Class

The Police Supervision class contains vital information for first and second-line supervisors. The prerequisite for the Police Supervision class is a student who was recently promoted or on a waiting list to be promoted in the very near future. Program to include: Roles & Responsibilities, Leading Individuals and Groups, Effective Stress Management, Liability Issues, Creating & Maintaining an Ethical Culture, Communications, Performance Management, as well as other areas. This comprehensive supervision series was created to foster a life-long practice of effective leadership in police organizations. This course is designed for sworn supervisors.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Class participants are sworn law enforcement personnel, first or second-line supervisors or soon to be promoted.

CLASS DATES AND LOCATION: See your agency training coordinator; the information is available via the ASSC online Registration System.

REGISTRATION:

- Registration is completed online in the ASSC system by agency training coordinators.
- There is no cost for course materials.

OUT OF TOWN STUDENTS:

Hotel reservations will be made by AZ POST and directly pay hotel room/tax costs for **sworn** personnel who reside and work more than 50 miles from the class. Sworn personnel per diem costs will be reimbursed to agencies according to the current Arizona Reimbursement Rate Index. If students live within 50 miles from the class, AZ POST cannot pay per diem.
